THE KNOWLEDGE CENTRE

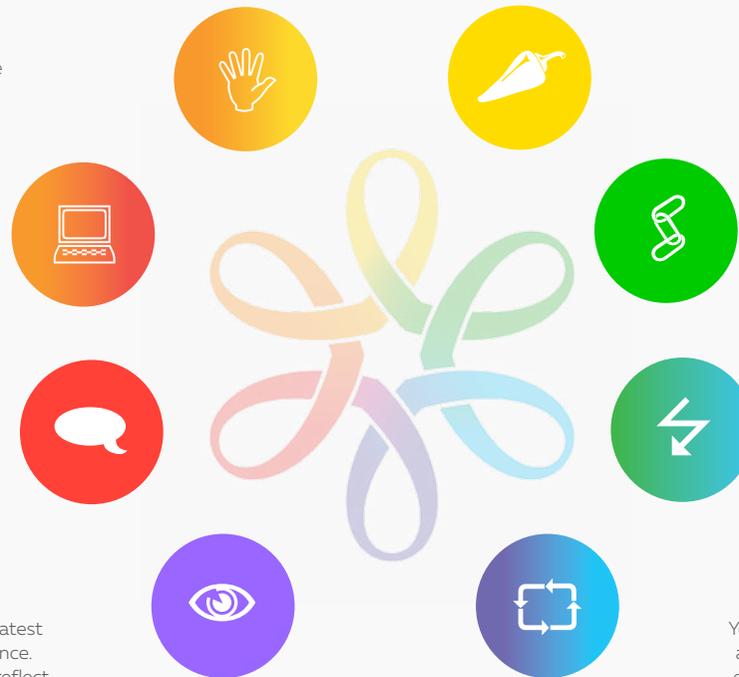
