Purpose

This skill set reflects the skill requirements for the provision of basic financial literacy education. This skill set is for community workers whose clients may be facing issues related to the basic day to day management of their finances and who may be at risk of increasing debt and its associated risks. It provides a set of skills for provision of basic financial literacy education for clients and is not to be confused with financial counselling.

Units of competency

CHCEDU007	Provide group education on consumer credit and debt

Skill Set Requirements

This skill set has been endorsed by industry as suitable for individuals who:

- hold a qualification at Certificate III level or higher in Community Services, Health or related field; or
- have skills equivalent to the qualification requirement validated through a recognition of prior learning process

Course Credit and RPL

ICAN learn may grant credit or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), if a participant can provide both sufficient and relevant evidence. RPL is not free and a fee is charged for each unit. To apply for credit transfer a participant must provide certified evidence of an academic award and transcript or statement of attainment.

Award

On successful completion of all units of competency in CHCSS00077 Financial Literacy Education, the student will be issued with a Statement of Attainment.
